



Circle Train

1		<p>Gather all the students together in one large group in the middle of the room.</p>
2		<p>Pretend to be a train and walk around the group singing a song or chanting a vocabulary word. Stop at a random student.</p>
3		<p>Elicit a vocabulary word (if you weren't chanting one during Step 2) from this student and ask him to choose a certain number of friends to join the train. You can have him choose the number by using number cards for him to blind pick from, via a large fluffy die, or you can just designate the number for him after having him ask "How many people?"</p>
4		<p>These students join the train and you repeat the process from Step 2.</p>

- Tips:
- A fluffy die is fun to use, but you run the risk of having everyone roll sixes and having the game over too quickly. Have several playing cards for the student and "stack the deck" with 2s and 3s to better control the length of the game.
 - If the homeroom teacher is included in the group, don't let them be chosen until the very last lap – having only one student sitting down, with everyone marching around him, can be a bit intimidating for the student and you may have some criers.
